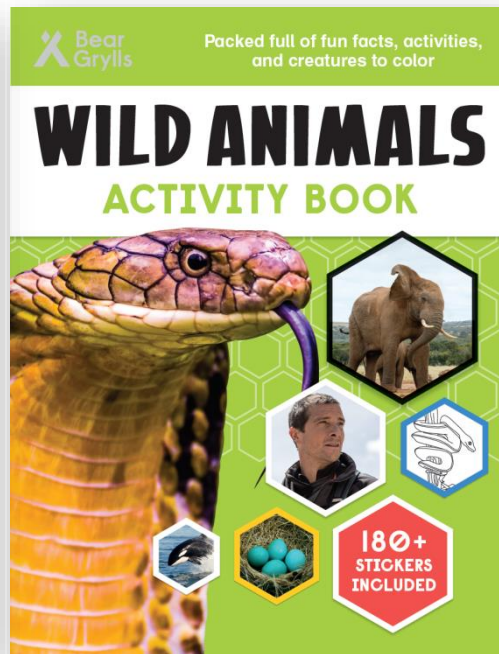
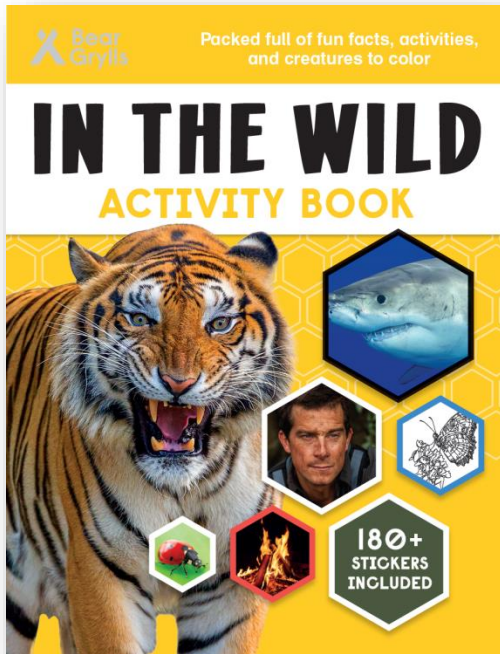

### HABITAT: POLAR REGIONS

The Arctic and the Antarctic are the Earth's icy extremes. The Arctic is the largely frozen ocean and land that surrounds the North Pole, and the Antarctic is the land around the South Pole. The animals in these places must cope with very long, cold, and dark winters. Even the summers are cool, and much of the ground and sea remains covered in ice.

### BIG CATS

Lions, leopards, and tigers are known as "big cats." They are among the most dangerous predators on the planet. With their razor-sharp teeth, deadly claws, and awesome strength and speed, it's not uncommon for these mighty beasts to hunt down animals as large as elephants and rhinoceroses. Cheetahs are the world's fastest land mammals, and can reach speeds of up to 70 miles per hour. Tigers are the largest cats in the world, growing up to 10 feet long. And the majestic lion has the most powerful roar that can be heard up to 5 miles away.
