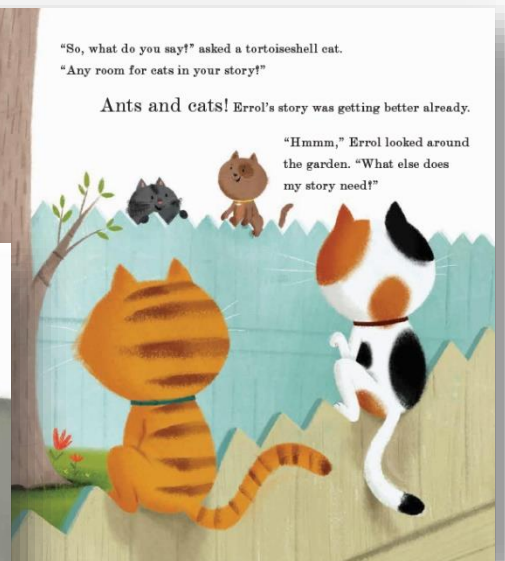
As soon as Errol starts to tell his story, all the creatures in the garden overhear, and they all want to be the hero!

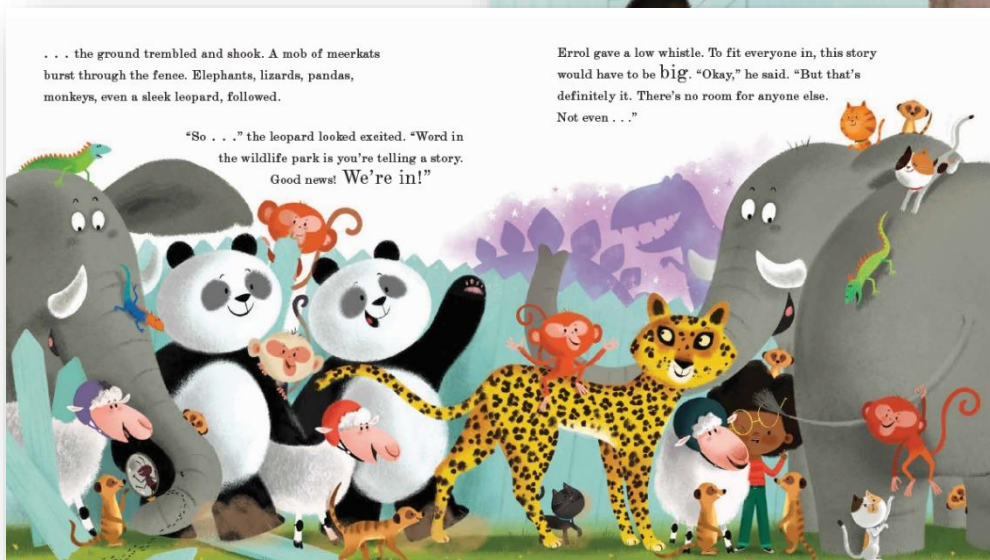
A tabby cat was tapping Errol's foot.
