Before reading the book, open the cover to show both front and back.

- Can you see a mammoth? What is he wearing?
- How many penguins have cameras?
- How many penguins are playing with snowballs?



After reading the book ...

- Find the penguins on the title page.
- Penguins are described as "fabulous," "cute," and "glorious." Think of some other words to describe penguins.
- How do you think the little explorer felt when no one believed him? Would you have believed him?
- What happens right after the little explorer stomps down on the ice and it cracks?
- Do you think the other mammoths believe that the little mammoth saw a human?
- What other funny things might the mammoth be wearing and doing? Draw and color your own picture of a mammoth wearing and doing whatever you come up with. Label the parts if you'd like.

Going further ...

- On a world map or globe, find the places where mammoths once lived.
- Using the Internet or books from the library, find a few more interesting facts about mammoths.
- Find out what the five kinds of penguins are that live in Australia. Draw a picture of them.
- If you can, visit a zoo that has penguins. Can you learn five more interesting things about them there? Or use the Internet or books from the library to learn more about them.
