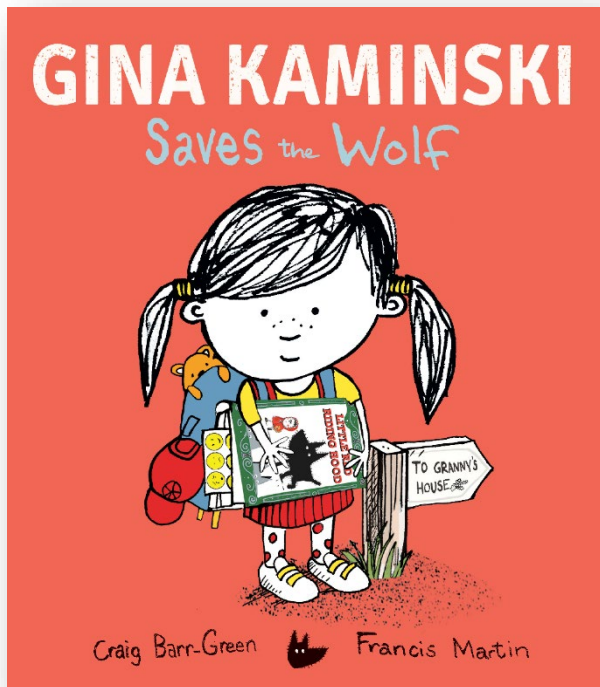


GINA KAMINSKI SAVES THE WOLF
