- Of all the journeys described in the book, which would you most like to take and why?
- Of all the sights and places shown in the book, which would you most like to experience and why?
 - Research to learn more about your chosen spot.
 - Imagine you're visiting and create a picture postcard to send a friend with a message about your experience.
- Make a list of all the different modes of travel described in the book. How many of them have you taken? Which would you most like to take and why? Where would you go?
- Consider your own community or anywhere not described in the book, where you've been or would want to visit.
 - Choose a starting place and a destination, and include a couple of interesting stops along the way. Plot your stops on a map of your own design.
 - Design a poster or brochure to promote your journey to adventure seekers in a style like the design of the book. Don't forget to include a "Fact File," a "Did you know" fun fact, and so on. Draw pictures or use a photograph of your own or from a magazine or the internet for "Snap this," "Discover this," "Visit this," and so on, highlighting your chosen stops and final destination.
