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EJ12: Girl Hero, Hot & Cold By Susannah McFarlane

#### Synopsis

EJ12's mission in *Hot* & *Cold* is to crack tricky codes and save the world from Dr. C. Hill, who is trying to melt the polar ice cap. Emma Jack's mission at school is to deal with a bully and stand up for her friends.

## • Code Breakers

The author's name and the book dedication are written in code. Once you've figured out the code, try writing your own name and book dedication using the same code pattern.

## Class Debate

A theme in the story is water and how precious water is. Would you agree or disagree that "water is more precious than gold?" Why or why not?

### • Palindromes

Palindromes are words that are spelled the same backward and forward. What palindromes can you find in the story? Can you think of any other palindromes?

### • What Is a Friend?

What are the characteristics of a good friend? What makes some people become bullies? Discuss ideas for creating a bully-free school.

### • Mapping Time

Can you find Antarctica and the South Pole on the map? Use Google Earth to see a real view. Calculate the distance from your home town to the South Pole.

### • Emperor Penguins

What do you know about Emperor penguins? See what you can find on the Internet regarding their description, habitat, diet, breeding, predators, interesting facts, pictures and photos.
