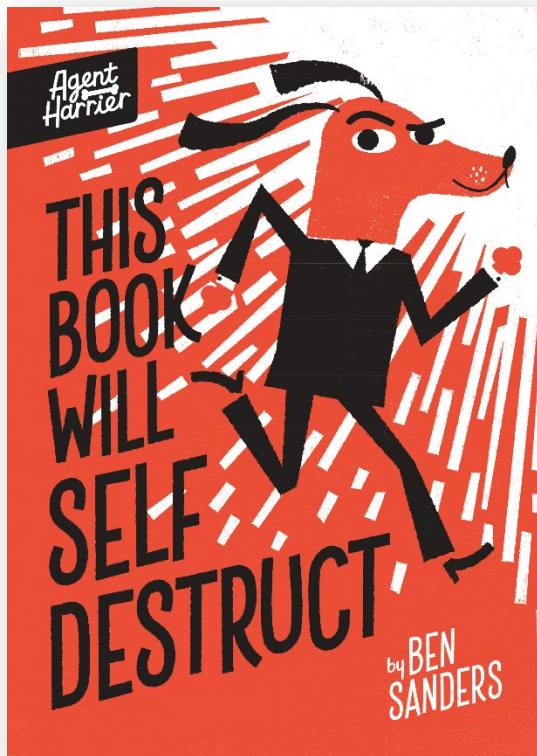


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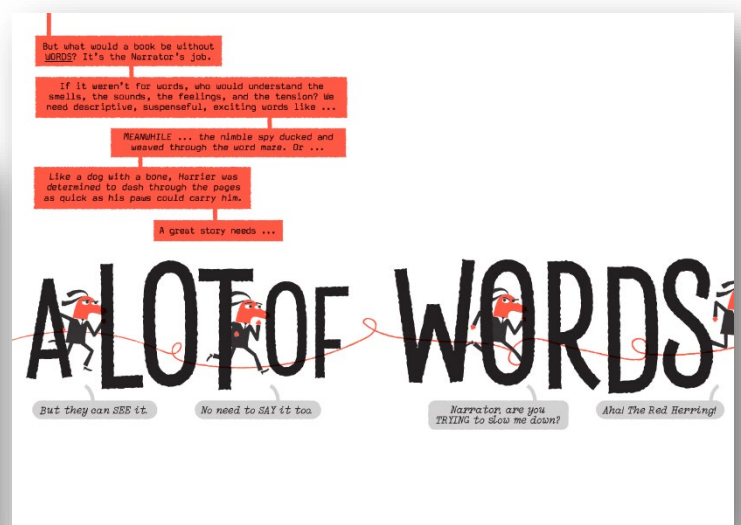

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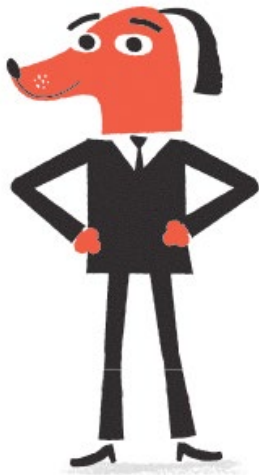


Additional Information

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Graphic novels (comic format) are considered literature by librarians and educators.

Graphic novels help develop critical reading skills needed for more challenging work.

Graphic novels contribute to visual literacy needed to critically interpret today's media-based narratives and information.

The format and use of humor motivates and engages reluctant readers.

Complexity and structure will satisfy advanced readers.

- **Serves as a springboard for homeschool/classroom discussion and learning activities**
 - Identify the elements of the book and discuss how they contribute to the reading experience: panels and gutters, dialogue or thought balloons, narrative text or captions, sound effects and motion lines, art style of characters, background, and use of color.
 - Look for and discuss any examples of literary devices, such as: metaphor and symbolism, point of view, puns and alliteration, intertextuality and inference, flashbacks, and foreshadowing.
 - Graphic novels have been compared to movies with the creator acting as a director and scene editor. Discuss in terms of this book.
 - What does “breaking the fourth wall” mean? What is “metafiction”? Discuss with respect to this book.
 - Create your own alternative ending, or an account of what happened before or will happen next for Agent Harrier, or create your own story.
